

## Day 1 (June 10, 2024)

### POCSO Act

Advocate Mr Mohan Murthy conducted a seminar on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act.

Topics covered: Classifications of child sexual abuse (physical, non-physical, and online grooming), causes and risk factors. The seminar aimed to educate staff on legal frameworks and implications for protecting children from sexual abuse and exploitation.



## Day 2 (June 11, 2024)

### Child Protection Policy

Mrs. Christobel Stevenson, Principal of Timpany Steel City School, led the gathering in prayer to commence the workshop. Advocate Mohan Murthy detailed the schools about Child Protection Policy. Key elements included prevention of child abuse, corporal punishment, and discrimination. Staff were educated on creating a safe environment and prioritizing child safety through physical, personal, cyber, and social-economic safety measures. Plans were announced for establishing a Child Protection Committee and appointing a Child Protection Officer (CPO), emphasizing their roles in safeguarding children's well-being.


Day 3 (June 12, 2024)

## PUPIL HEALTH PAVILION



As we celebrated this milestone, everyone expressed their deepest gratitude for Mrs. Meena Devi's tireless efforts.



# WEBINAR ON "RAJA RAM MOHAN ROY: FATHER OF INDIAN RENAISSANCE"

In the series of various programmes organized on Indian languages, a webinar based on "Raja Ram Mohan Roy: Father of Indian Renaissance" was organized by the Training Unit, CBSE, on his Birth anniversary, the 22nd of May, 2024. Prof. Tanuja Majumdar, Professor, Hindi Department, Presidency University, Kolkata spoke about Raja Ram Mohan Roy (22 May 1772 – 27 September 1833) who was a renowned Indian reformer and is considered to be the "Father of Indian Renaissance" by many historians.

Born in Hooghly District of West Bengal, his influence was apparent in politics, public administration, education and religion. He was one of the founders of the Brahma Samaj in 1828, one of the most influential social-religious reform movements of the time, which exposed religious hypocrisies and played a major role in reforming and modernizing Indian society. He was known for his efforts to abolish the practices of Sati and Child marriage. The students of Stds 6 to 12 and the teaching faculty attended the webinar.





## SKILL DEVELOPMENT COURSES


